**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all bowlers, male and female. Participants are required to fill out a NO FEE Membership Form.

**ENTRY FEES:** \$49 for each division and \$95 for both. All re-entries \$39. Cash only will be accepted at Royal Z Lanes. There will NOT be any refunds once tournament starts.

**CHECK IN TIME:** At least half (1/2) hour prior to each squad time.

**ENTERING AVERAGES:** All new bowlers will use their highest adult USBC certified league yearbook 08-09 average; must provide proper average verification for the current season and previous 2 years.

FORMAT: Participants will bowl 3 games across 6 lanes, moving one pair to the right of each game with one lane courtesy only.  
**2 GAMES ELIMINATION EXAMPLE: 10 BOWLERS BOWL 2 GAMES CUT TO TOP 4, 4 BOWLERS BOWL 1 GAME cut to 2, 2 bowlers bowl 1 game to determine champion. PLEASE NOTE, THE HIGH OUT OVER ALL SQUADS GETS A 1<sup>ST</sup> ROUND BYE FOR THE SEMIS IN BOTH DIVISIONS.**

**HANDICAP ALLOWANCE:** The handicap for this tournament will be based on **90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 225 in the 2008-2009 yearbooks.** Average above 225 receive zero (0) handicap. Maximum handicap for men is 60 and for ladies 70. If no proof of average, men will be rated at 200; women at 180. Director reserves the right to re-rate to a higher or lower average at his discretion before and after 21 or more games in the tournament.

**HANDICAP GAIN/LOSS:** Winner will lose 1 HDCP pin for every \$100 earned in standings. If bowler wins twice in a row, the bowler will lose an additional 6 HDCP pins on the 2<sup>nd</sup>. Win. Participants will only earn 1 extra HDCP bonus pin when they do not cash to a maximum of 12 pins. If bowler cashes, this rule does not apply.

**SCORING:** 3 games qualifying semis.

**Reminder: if any bowler wishes to bowl any squad for the side action only, the bowler may do so by paying a \$10 lineage fee plus the side action fees in brackets, nassaus and multi doubles. Bowler must bowl a minimum of 2 squads in order for this rule to take effect.**

**DISTRIBUTION OF PRIZE FUNDS: BOTH DIVISIONS ARE GUARANTEED \$800 for 1<sup>st</sup>. PLACE. ALL TOP 10 WILL CASH. The prize fund ratio will be one out of every 6 entries will cash.** In the event of a tie, the first and second place prize funds will be added together and then divided equally. Director reserves the right to adjust prize fund based on the number of entries. **Handicap and scratch divisions will be a guaranteed first place prize regardless of number of entries.**

**GENERAL RULES OF CONDUCT:** Bad conduct, rudeness or profanity will not be tolerated; bowlers conducting themselves improperly may be disqualified and or penalized by director without a refund – no exceptions or a zero frame warning.

Director is not responsible for typing errors and is not to be held accountable.
