62nd March of Dimes Tournament Rules

1. This tournament is USBC Certified and all USBC rules will govern this tournament.
2. Entry fee is \$17.00 per person per event. Entry fee breakdown is as follows: Prize Fee \$4.00, Lineage \$6.00, Expenses \$3.00, March of Dimes \$4.00. Handicap and Scratch (new this year) All Events are an additional (optional) \$5.00 fee each per bowler.
3. Handicap will be computed on the basis of 80% of the difference between the bowler's average and 220.
4. Entering Average Rule:
 - a. Highest USBC sanctioned winter league average (yearbook) for the 2008-09 season.
 - b. If no 2008-09 winter average then use the highest 2008-09 sanctioned summer league average, minimum of 21 games. The Association Manager will verify.
 - c. If neither a. nor b. applies then the current season average as of December 31, 2009, minimum of 21 games will be used. League Secretary will verify.
 - d. If none of the above applies then a scratch average of 220 will be used.
5. Rule 319d, Reporting Prior Prize Winnings, will not be in effect.
6. All bowlers are cautioned to be familiar with USBC Rule 319e concerning average adjustment. NOTE: The ten (10) pin rule will not apply in this tournament.
7. Participants in this tournament must have a current USBC membership.
8. The prize ratio for Team, Doubles and Singles will be one (1) cash award per eight (8) entries. All Events, Handicap and Scratch, prize ratio will be one (1) cash award per fifteen (15) entries.
9. Tournament prize money will not be awarded until the Tournament Director has verified winner's averages in accordance with USBC Rule 319a.
10. Team Captains must check in thirty (30) minutes before squad time. Substitutions may be made at this time. There will be no changes in the team line-up unless substitutions are involved.
11. This is a multiple participation tournament. Rule 315 applies.
12. The first time a bowler bowls Singles they must also bowl Doubles and vice versa. Once a bowler has completed the first set of Singles and Doubles they may re-enter in either event provided lanes are available. When bowling Singles and Doubles, Singles will be contested first. Singles with Mixed Doubles is an option and is not required to be bowled.
13. **Mixed Team entries will consist of two (2) men and two (2) women. Mixed Doubles will be one (1) man and one (1) woman.**
14. **New this year. Singles is being offered along with Mixed Doubles and is an OPTION.**
15. **There is NO All Events for the Mixed Events.**
16. Entry fee MUST accompany the entry form. Please send check or money order made out to the March of Dimes Bowling Tournament.
17. Errors in posted scores must be reported to the Tournament Director within twenty-four (24) hours after posting.
18. Out of area bowlers will be given preference in squad times over Greater Charleston area bowlers for the 2nd and 3rd weekends of the tournament.
19. All prize fees will be returned 100% in the event from which collected.
20. The Charleston Rifle Club is a private club and has a very limited supply of shoes and bowling balls for use.
