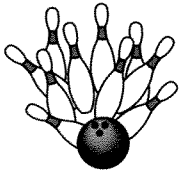

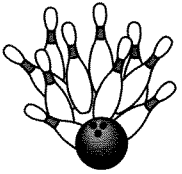

ABOUT CHILDHOOD CANCER

- Approximately 10,400 children under the age of 15 are diagnosed with cancer yearly.
- Statistics estimate that 1,545 children will die of cancer this year.
- Cancer is the primary cause of death in children under the age of 15.
- For every 10,000 kids in the U.S., 1 to 2 will develop some form of childhood cancer each year.
- Those who have survived childhood cancer are at a higher risk for developing cancer again as adults.
- These statistics don't even include adolescents age 15-18. The numbers for "our" kids are so much higher when looking through the eyes of a parent or loved one.



WHAT IS COURAGEOUS KIDZ?

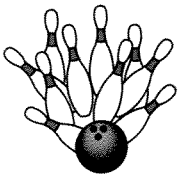

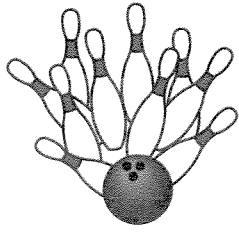

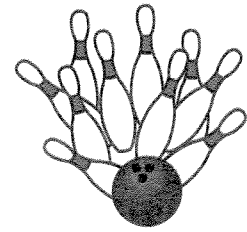
