**PLEASE READ CAREFULLY – “A3Sports EXTRAVAGANZA” RULES**

Rules of USBC and “A3Sports EXTRAVAGANZA” as stated herein, will govern this tournament and participants. THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MODIFY TOURNAMENT FORMAT AND RULES AS DEEMED FAIR, APPROPRIATE AND NECESSARY. The Tournament Committee has the right to resolve all questions and disputes arising. The Tournament Committee’s decisions shall be final and binding.

1. Open to all USBC-Sanctioned bowlers; Bowlers may re-enter as often as they wish, but may cash only once with the same partner. Teams may be comprised of any combination. Host center employees are allowed to participate in the tournament but cannot bowl together. PBA “STANDARD” members are eligible to participate, but cannot bowl together. PBA “FULL” members (or if you have won a Regional or National title) are allowed to participate, but cannot bowl together. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to reject any entry and entry fee.

2. **ENTRY FEES:** WE ACCEPT CASH ONLY!!! (No Personal Checks, Certified Checks, Money Orders or Credit Cards). Participants must be present and entry fees paid 30 minutes prior to start times. No refund will be made after the entry has been received and scheduled to bowl. Tournament Director reserves the right to add additional squads.

3. **AVERAGES:** All participants must provide accurate average for their highest USBC-certified average for the year (2009-2010), regardless of hand. If a bowler has no USBC-certified average for the past year, the bowler must provide average verification of their highest current 2008-2009 average. Bowlers without certified averages will be considered a 210 Scratch bowler and receive no handicap. IT SHALL BE EACH BOWLER’S RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY THE ACCURACY OF THE SUBMITTED AVERAGE. FAILURE TO USE THE CORRECT AVERAGE SHALL DISQUALIFY SCORE, IF SUBMITTED AVERAGE IS LOWER THAN THE CORRECT AVERAGE, THEREBY RESULTING IN MORE HANDICAP. Corrections to average are permitted up to completion of the first game.

4. **HANDICAP RATIO:** Male - 80% of 205 \ Female – 80% of 210 \ Seniors (55 & over) – 80% of 210

5. **PRIZE REPORTING:** USBC Rules 319-A2 (Ten-Pin Rule), 319d and 319e do apply. It is the participant’s responsibility to submit (in writing) to the Tournament Director, a report of earnings of \$500.00 or more in certified and non-certified tournaments during the past 12 month period. Failure to provide actual score, position and amount prior to bowling will result in disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees. The Tournament Director and Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry, adjust any participant’s average upward or readjust any participant’s handicap points/pins prior to tournament entry or reentry. If a participant’s average is adjusted, they have the right to decline the adjustment prior to bowling, and receive a refund of entry fees paid.

6. **FORMAT:** This is a Handicap event. Participants will bowl 4 games, skipping 1 pair of lanes to the right after every game.

\* **SINGLES:** Female and Male Payouts are separate. Winners will be determined by total pin count for the 4 games.

\* **DOUBLES Alibis:** Participants may pay an additional fee of \$10.00 each to alibi with a partner during the 2<sup>nd</sup> game. Winners of Doubles Alibi event will be determined by total pin count. Doubles Prize fund based on

entries.

\* **TRIOS Alibis:** Participants may pay an additional fee of \$10.00 each to alibi with 2 partners during the 3<sup>rd</sup> game.

Winners of Trios Alibi event will be determined by total pin count. Trios Prize Fund based on entries.

\* **DOUBLES\TRIOS Alibis (Optional)** may consist of any combination.

Participants may re-enter and alibi multiple times, but may cash only once with the same partner(s).

Ties will be broken with a 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll-off.

7. **PRIZE FUND:** PAYOFF RATIO is 1:10. Prize fund is 100% returned, based on entries. PAYOUT will be within 30 days from end of tournament. All prize awards will be considered final, as published by the Tournament Committee. No legal action for prize money may be brought after prize monies are issued. Bowlers will not be allowed to forfeit any winnings.

8. Automatic scorers will be used to compute scores. Participants may not record their own scores. Any corrections to scores during tournament play must be made and/or verified by a tournament official.

9. **DRESS CODE & PERSONAL CONDUCT:** NO tank tops, “Short” shorts or cut-offs. No obscene attire. All issues regarding appropriate attire will be decided by tournament committee. Profanity, cheating or abuse of equipment will not be allowed. No smoking permitted in the facility. ONLY PARTICIPATING BOWLERS SHOULD BE SEATED IN THE BOWLER’S AREA.

10. Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency or emergency causes relating to; fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties, weather or other reasons beyond the control of Tournament Director shall cause all advertised prizes, guarantees or otherwise to be lifted and prorated in accordance with the number of entries which have been bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of termination. Scores lost due to power failure or mechanical failure must be re-bowled (USBC 327C). No money will be refunded.

Any appeal regarding tournament scores shall be made in writing to Tournament Director. Action will be in compliance with USBC rules.
