# Tournament Rules

1. United States Bowling Congress rules and regulations will govern this tournament.
2. Teams will have 5 members. Teams may be any combination of Men, Women, or Mixed.
3. Highest sanctioned league averages will be used for this tournament. To be eligible for handicap, each bowler must use their highest yearbook average of a minimum of 21 games in a sanctioned league during the 2007-2008 season. Summer league averages are excluded unless entrant does not have a 2007-2008 Winter league average. When using a summer league average, the 21 game rule will apply. A bowler without a 2007-2008 average must use their highest 2008-2009 season average (based on a minimum of 21 games) as of February 1, 2009. A bowler with none of the above averages will bowl without handicap. **Note!!! An entrant having a current (2008-2009) season average as of February 1, 2009, which is ten or more pins higher than their previous season (2007-2008) average, shall use the current 2008-2009 season average.**
4. The pay ratio will be at least 1 in 6 entries.
5. Bowlers shall submit themselves for re-rating in this tournament and shall be re-rated before bowling according to the re-rating requirements of the USBC rule 319C, 319D, and 319E, as shown in the 2008-2009 USBC rule book.
6. All handicaps will be figured on the basis of 90% of the difference in the bowlers' average and 210.
7. All averages must be verified prior to bowling. Any sanctioned averages outside of the Rowan-Mooresville USBC Association must bring average verification to the tournament.
8. Any bowler submitting a false average will be disqualified and receive 0 for the games bowled. Entries will be accepted up until the squad time on a first come first serve basis.
9. **Entry fees:** Total of \$200.00 per team entry, \$145.00 prize fund, \$50.00 bowling fees, and \$5.00 expense fee.
10. **Side pots:** An optional High Game and High series pot will be taken up. Cost will be \$5.00 Scratch and \$5.00 Handicap. Brackets will be \$6.00 each and will pay \$30.00 1<sup>st</sup> and \$10.00 2<sup>nd</sup>. High games, high set, and brackets will be run on an individual basis and paid out after each squad.
11. Any team re-entering the afternoon squad must have at least two bowlers different than the team entered in the morning squad.
12. **The Tournament Director reserves the right to make the final decision on all rule discrepancies in the best interest of the Tournament.**
