

June 8 Game Scratch Results:

The June Traveling 8 Game Scratch Tournament was held at Ashley Lanes on June 13th, 2010. The tournament had 26 entries and paid \$380 for first place.

Leading the qualifying with a total pin fall of 1905 for a 238 average was David Tolson of Charleston, SC. The tournament still paid out the top 5 spots and the remainders of the qualifiers were:

2. Ken Simard – 1892
3. Pete Wagner – 1868
4. Jason Fitzgerald – 1804
5. Chris Arcaro – 1788

The top 5 bowlers moved on to the stepladder finals. In the first match, Chris Arcaro defeated Jason Fitzgerald 265 – 236. Jason received \$60 for his 5th place finish.

In the second match of the day, Chris Arcaro and Pete Wagner put on a battle to the final frames. Pete opened the door for Chris when he opened in 10th frame with a split. Chris stepped up in the 10th and locked out Pete by throwing the first 2 strikes and went on to defeat Pete by the score of 237 – 230. Pete took home \$110 for his 4th place finish.

The third match of the day put Chris up against former exempt pro Ken Simard. Ken showed no signs of the break between qualifying and his match as he easily defeated Chris 248 – 206. Chris took home \$160 for his 3rd place finish.

The championship match pitted the top two qualifiers against each other, David Tolson and Ken Simard. David was making his second consecutive championship match appearance. Both bowlers came out striking and put us on track for an exciting finish. In the end, David could not keep up with Ken's strikes and wound up falling to Ken 278 – 257. David took home \$190 for his 2nd place finish. Congratulations to Ken Simard for winning the July event and the \$380 first place prize.
