

VANDERHOEF WINS THE UPSTATE FALL CLASSIC!

Lee Vanderhoef from Greenville, S.C. led and won the Turbo Driven To Bowl Fall Challenge at Paradise Lanes in Spartanburg, S.C. Vandy was in top form as he was able to master the lane conditions with consistent strong scores. We used the Kegel Middle of the Road pattern for this tournament. The pattern is 39 ft. in length and provided a challenging but score able pattern.

Vandy led all qualifiers by shooting 1157 for 5 games. The cut to make matchplay was 1054. We cut to the top 11 for matchplay this month. The top 5 bowlers received first round byes. The 6th seed, Scott McKown, from Hickory N.C. making his first matchplay appearance faced off against the 11th seed, Mike Albert from Shallotte, N.C. Albert was able to win the match with ease 212-156. The 7th seed, Brad Cummings from Gaffney, S.C. took on the 10th seed, Lee Bowlin from Lincolnton, N.C. Bowlin posted the first 300 game of the 2009-2010 season to start off qualifying. The match was close until the end. Cummings was able to hold off Bowlin 255-229.

The match of the first round was Ken Simard, the 8th seed against the 9th seed Brian Osteen. Both of these players are from the upstate of S.C. and both are currently bowling the PBA South Region circuit. This match went into extra frames to break a 227-227 tie. Simard was able to win the tiebreaker 50-39. During the round of 8 no drama was to be found. Vanderhoef defeated Simard 258-191. Randy Weiss the 4th seed from Columbia S.C. defeated the 5th seed Shawn McKee from Mooresville N.C. 248-141. The 2nd seed, Michael Painter from Spartanburg, S.C. defeated Cummings 245-201. The 3rd seed, Darryl Ratliff, from Charlotte, N.C. defeated Albert 232-181.

Round of 4 featured a blow out and a tight match. Vandy was able to hold off Weiss 224-214. Painter dusted off Ratliff 279-173. The title match was a battle of upstate S.C. Vanderhoef tripled in the tenth to shut out Painter 217-195.
